THREE FACTS ABOUT DISAPPOINTMENT

I. THE GREATEST SUCCESSES IN LIFE ARE OFTEN FOLLOWED BY FAILURE.

"Then Moses led Israel from the <u>Red Sea</u> and they went into the Desert of Shur. For <u>three</u> <u>days</u> they traveled in the desert without finding water." vs. 22

Marah: "bitter" (vs. 26)

II. THE GREATEST SERVICES IN LIFE ARE OFTEN FOLLOWED BY FORGETFULNESS.

"So the people grumbled against Moses saying, `What are we to drink?""

vs. 24

What to do with disappointment?

* DON'T CURSE IT

"Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse!" Romans 12: 14

* DON'T REHEARSE IT

"To worry yourself to death with resentment would be a foolish thing to do."

Job 5:2 (GN)

"Get rid of all bitterness ... anger, and slander, along with every form of malice." Eph. 4:31

* DON'T NURSE IT

"Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold."

Eph. 4:26-27

"You are only hurting yourself with your anger!"

Job 18:4

Instead:

* YOU DISPERSE IT

"Then Moses cried out to the Lord."

vs. 25

"Cast all your cares on Him, because He cares for you."

1 Peter 5:7

* LET GOD REVERSE IT

"You intended to harm me but God intended it for good..."

Gen. 50:20

"All things work together for good"

Romans 8:28

III. THE GREATEST SHORTAGES IN LIFE ARE OFTEN FOLLOWED BY FULLNESS.

"Then they came to Elim where there were twelve springs and seventy palm trees And they camped near the water." vs. 27
